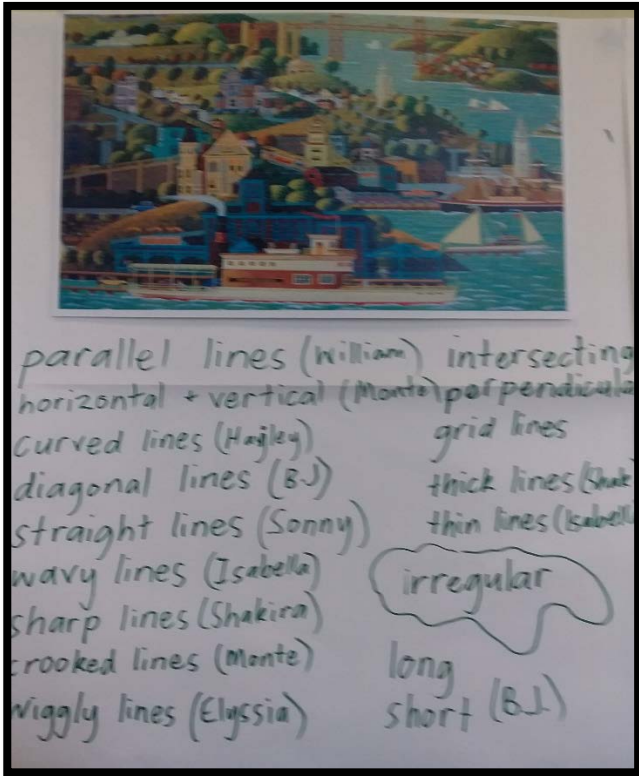

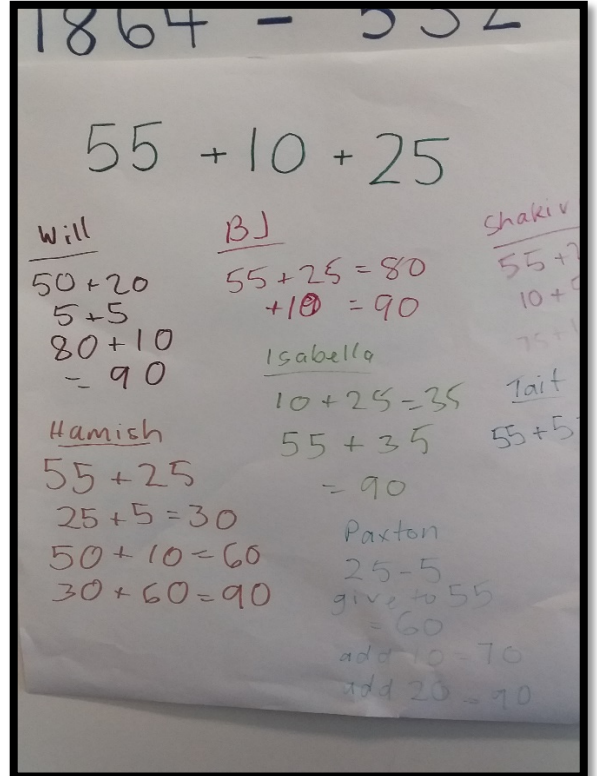

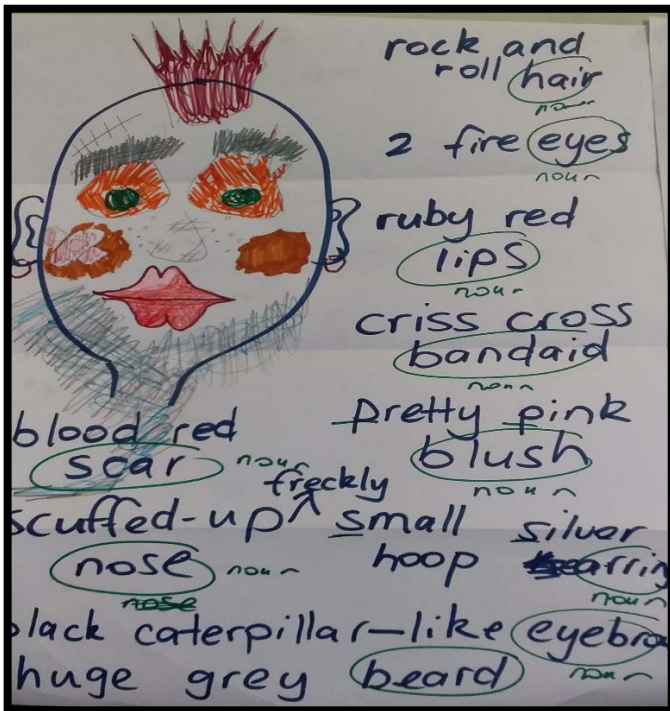
## What inspired this work?

**We used an artwork to detect what Mathematics we could see in real life.**



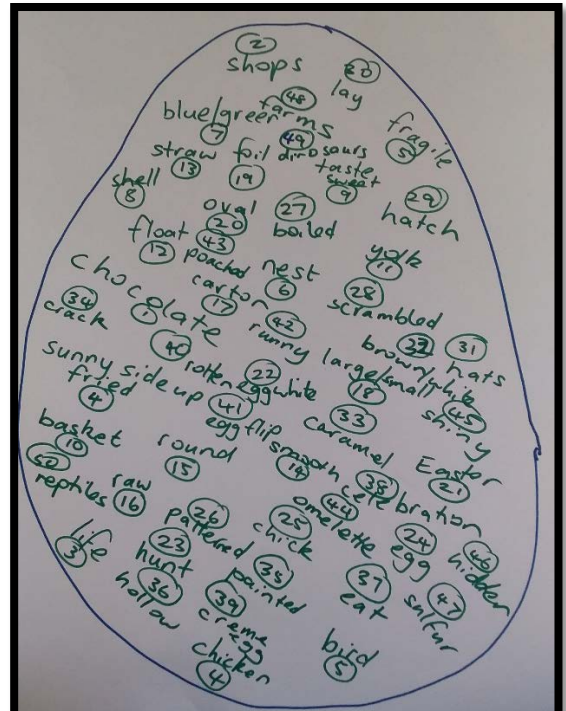
