

### **Borambola Excursion (3-6)**

Final preparations are being made for the **Term 4 Borambola Excursion for 3-6 students**. A detailed note will be sent out this week outlining what needs to be completed by parents in the lead up. Any overnight excursion requires several forms to be completed to ensure your child is catered for. Borambola Sport and Recreation Centre requires the completion of an **online Medical Consent Form**. I have included instructions on how to complete (including the link to follow) in the note however if you require assistance do not hesitate to contact the school.

The sooner you are able to complete the tasks outlined in the note the better! A final price is also included in the note. This total will need to be paid by the due date listed to guarantee your child's place on the excursion. Please note that this total has been subsidised by the **Wamoon PS P & C- \$100.00 per child!** Wamoon PS will also be paying for the bus used to transport to and from Wagga Wagga.

### IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT USE OF WELLBEING PROGRAM (CANTEEN)

As all parents are aware, we run a Wellbeing Program (Canteen) 5 x days a week. This program is used heavily by families on a daily basis. Whilst this is fine, I would like to highlight the following arrangements which will come into place from tomorrow Tuesday, August 20.

- The current system of using a 'board' to keep track of credit/debits will be removed.
- Credits are welcome however must be arranged at the office.
- All orders must be paid for either in advance or on the day.
- If you require the school to arrange food for your child please advise by note or phone call. A debit will be sent home.
- Students who arrive to school without food will be provided with a menu item only (no drinks) and a debit will be sent home.

tough field, Sonny managed to finish 13<sup>th</sup> (out of 19) in both race which is a fantastic effort! Sonny has had a fantastic sporting year!






### NSWPSSA Small Schools Knockout - Round 3

### Tell Them From Me (TTFM) - Parent Survey

This Term, our school will be participating in the *Partners in Learning* parent survey, another part of the *Tell Them From Me* suite of surveys (student, teacher and parent surveys) on student engagement. The survey asks parents and carers questions about different factors that are known to impact on student wellbeing and engagement.

Running this survey will help our school understand parents' and carers' perspectives on their child's experience at school. These include: communication between parents/carers and staff, activities and practices at home and parent/carer views on the school's support of learning and behaviour. This valuable feedback will help our school make practical improvements.

The survey is conducted entirely online on smartphones, iPads, tablets, laptops or computers. The survey will typically take 15 minutes or less to complete and is completely confidential. The parent survey will be conducted between 26 August and 25 October. Although participating in the survey is entirely voluntary, your responses are very much appreciated.

We want to get as many parents respond to this survey as possible! We are aiming to reach 80% of families. Your responses matter a great deal to school planning and for staff to reflect on what is important to the community.




All families who complete the survey will go into the draw to win a \$100.00 Golden Apple Voucher. To be eligible for the draw the survey must be
