Just to clarify, from time to time, issues may arise at school which need to be bought to the attention of your child's classroom teacher or in some cases myself (if not your child's teacher). Please be sure to arrange a time to have a conversation (preferred) or contact the school. Quite often, we are able to sort out the smaller matters with ease.

This year we will again have a strong focus on supporting positive attendance at our school. We aim for 90% of our students attending school 92% of the time. Regular attendance makes a massive difference to student achievement. Quite simply, if students are not at school, they cannot learn. Today I have sent home absence notification requests for unexplained absences over the last two weeks. I'm a little concerned that we are tracking on an downward plane so far this term (see attendance section over the following pages). Schools Clean Up Day

Our students will spend some time this Thursday participating in this initiative provide by **Clean Up Australia Day.** We will focus on our school grounds, Wamoon Park area, Oxley Road and Bourke Road. We will provide bags and gloves for students however encourage students to bring their own from home if they prefer.



NSW COVID Safe Check-In

A reminder that all visitors to school need to scan the QR code at the entrance to our school when visiting. The only exception to this rule is currently for parents of Kindergarten students who are allowed to enter the school

ground for drop off and pick up. All other visitors, who have an appointment need to sign in before entering as per the Department of Education requirements. Please see me if you have any questions or need support downloading the Service NSW App.

School Operations Update

As of Term 1, the following updates have been applies to school operations (PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO READ (3))

- From Term 1 2021, all NSW public schools use the Service NSW <u>COVID Safe Check-inExternal link</u>.
- Look for the COVID Safe QR code posters when you enter our school. Be sure to sign in at the school administration building according to your school's visitor guidelines. Parents and carers who are only




- dropping off and picking up students do not need to check in using the Service NSW QR code.
- Inline with public health orders, our students can now attend external excursions providing there is a COVID safe plan in operation.
- Bubblers and drinking fountains can now be used however water bottles are still preferred however not mandatory
- Our school will still receive a day clean (during school hours) of all high contact surfaces. We will receive additional stocks of hygiene supplies to ensure our students have access.

Home Reading/Library Program has BEGUN!

Last week, all students were provided with their very own pouch and first reader/Library book to kickstart our **Home Reading/Library Program.** So far, our students have made an encouraging start with many reporting back they have engaged in reading at home!

I have had a few questions already and would like to clarify;

- Readers can be returned and swapped at school when you child has finished. We would like students to keep the reader for at least 2-3 nights to ensure they are practicing accurate reading.
- Library Books can be swapped on the library day which applies to your child's class (see below)
- Every time your child reads independently or with an adult, you must sign their reading log for this entry to count towards the incentive prizes.

To encourage our students to engage in the program, we have come up with the following incentives. Please note that these will change over time as we have higher expectations on the number of nights which students should be reading. Book Vouchers however will not change at 30/50 night intervals.

10 NIGHTS= Ice Block Voucher at School

20 NIGHTS= Fancy Bookmark Prize

30 NIGHTS= \$5.00 Scholastic Book Club Voucher

40 NIGHTS= Voice Recorder (great for recording reading aloud)

50 NIGHTS= \$10.00 Scholastic Book Voucher

With the onset of warmer weather and higher UV exposure the following measures will take place to ensure students are safe beginning first day back of Term 4.

- All students MUST wear a wide brimmed hat on the playground. This hat is preferably a school hat however other types will be allowed (as long as they are wide brimmed)
- Sunscreen will be made available to all students before leaving the classroom.
- Students will be instructed to have water breaks (during extreme heat) and if required engage in passive activities in classrooms/covered area.

Supporting Positive School Attendance at Wamoon Public School

Regular attendance at school is essential for students to achieve quality life outcomes. Schools, in partnership with parents, are responsible for promoting the regular attendance of students.


Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral.

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unjustified on the student's record.



A reminder to utilise our School App to record absence notifications. This is our preferred method however you can still write a note or phone the school to record a justification.



Key Points

-We are aiming to have students attend school 92% of the time. This aligns with NSW DoE targets

Our rate is on a downward plane which is a little concerning.

How to apply for and redeem vouchers

2 Visit service.nsw.gov.au and create or login to your MyServiceNSW Account

Complete an Active Kids application through your MyServiceNSW Account.
You will receive a voucher with a unique ID number for each child you register (available to download, print and email).

Redeem your voucher

Take your child's voucher to a registered activity provider; or log onto your provider's website to enrol and enter the voucher ID number.

When your child commences their chosen sport or activity, your online account will show the status of the voucher change from 'Active' to 'Redeemed'.
